Raise the Canadian Flag - Ceremony



The Canadian-Muslim Vote's Flag Campaign Launch at the Jaffari Community Centre

The Jaffari Community Centre (JCC) is pleased to be the first mosque to raise a Canadian flag as part of the Canadian-Muslim Vote's flag campaign. This initiative is the first of its kind and aims to raise a Canadian flag in front of mosques across the country in celebration of Canada's 150th Birthday in July 2017.

More than 200 community members gathered in the afternoon at JCC on Friday, 9 September 2016, for the inaugural flag raising ceremony, which was also attended by several federal and local politicians, including Member of Parliament (MP) Leona Alleslev (Aurora — Oak Ridges — Richmond Hill), MP Majid Jowhari (Richmond Hill), MP Hon. Peter Kent (Thornhill), MP Deborah Schulte (King-Vaughan) and Councillor Sandra Yeung Racco (Ward 4, Vaughan). Members of the local police and community member Lieutenant Colonel Arif Hirji, CD, Canadian Armed Forces were also present.

To mark this patriotic occasion, As-Sadiq Islamic School's Grade 3 students sang the national anthem as Councillor Racco and Lieutenant Colonel Arif Hirji raised the flag, which proudly stands at the Ner Israel Drive entrance.

Shabbir Jaffer, Vice-President of ISIJ of Toronto, said "We are a community that believes not only in our faith and our principles but also in the need to contribute to the wider society through positive community outreach. We also take pride in our civic engagement, and raising our country's flag here demonstrates that we are proud Canadian Muslims."



Moving Forward - Jaffari Support Services/Jaffari Islamic Youth

The "Moving Forward: Creating and Sustaining Relationships" event organized by JSS and JIY and held at JCC on September 25th had a much higher turn out than expected. A number of important points were shared and discussed on the topics of obstacles in marriage and the spouse selection process by Sheikh Jaffer, brother Miqdad, sister Raihana and sister Zainab.

In the Holy Quran, there is an ayah which mentions, "With every difficulty, there will be ease." There will be hurdles in marriage but together we can overcome them; it is one's attitude that determines outcomes. When looking for a spouse, one must know oneself FIRST, then think about what one wants to find in a potential spouse.

Case studies were discussed in small groups, followed by a larger group discussion, sharing thoughts and insights. A lot of written and oral feedback was received from the event, with requests for similarly organized events targeted towards specific groups. Alhamdulillah we learned, shared and moved forward as a community.

Dental Screening for Syrian Refugees

Vaughan Muslim organizations offer Syrian refugees free dental screening, job workshops - by Yorkregion.com



Thousands of Syrian refugees are starting life from scratch in a new country with a new language here in Canada, but they're not alone.

Several Canadian organizations, families and individuals have given their time and effort to help new Canadian families adjust from a life of war to a life of peace.

The North American Shia Ithna Asheri Muslim Community Organization (NASIMCO) and the Jaffari Community Centre (JCC) in Vaughan are two organizations actively helping new government-sponsored Syrian families adjust to the massive change.

In a third collaborative effort this year to help Syrian refugees, NASIMCO and JCC hosted a free dental screening and informative workshop session for hundreds of Syrian refugees in the York Region and Toronto area Aug. 7.

"We have over 200 new Syrian-Canadians here today," said JCC assistant treasure Azim Panju. "We've got just under 100 volunteers including 15 dentists, dental hygienists and community members, English-speakers and Arabic translators as well."

Previous efforts from NASIMCO and JCC included organizing and delivering hygiene kits to families awaiting permanent housing, preparing backpacks for 300 children going to school and delivering donated household items to families upon settlement.

Sunday's workshops and screenings continued that helpful momentum in which the whole community is involved. New residents expressed their gratitude with English they've quickly learned.

Jaffari Education Board - Update


The Jaffari Education Board (JEB) is the committee that works on enhancing the education of our community through various events and initiatives.


Inshallah we hope that you download the app and enjoy the services available to you at your fingertips. As always we look forward to your feedback and suggestions.
