The Jaffari Community Condemns Shooting in Toronto's Danforth Area

Calls for increased gun control legislation and support for mental health services

Vaughan, ON, July 24, 2018 - The Islamic Shia Ithna Asheri Jamaat (ISIJ) of Toronto joins Canadians in condemning Sunday's ruthless shooting that took place in Toronto's Danforth area, leaving a child and young woman dead and 13 others injured.

"We are utterly saddened and horrified by this brutal incident and our hearts and prayers go out to the families and friends of the victims and the survivors and the entire community," said ISIJ of Toronto Vice President, Shafiq Ebrahim. "We thank the first responders, including the police and paramedics, as well as the countless civilians who helped the injured on Sunday night, showing true courage and compassion at this critical time of need," he added.

This tragic incident is an unfortunate stark reminder of the need for increased gun control in our cities and country. "We urgently and strongly call upon on our elected officials at the local, provincial and national levels, to introduce legislation that will curb gun ownership and ensure guns are not readily available," said Shafiq Ebrahim.

Likewise, it is critical to bring mental health concerns to the forefront and as Canadians commit to seeking and supporting mental health treatment and services. The Mental Health Commission of Canada reports that while one in five Canadians will experience mental health challenges in any given year, only one in three actually report seeking treatment.

We pray for God to give comfort to the victims, the survivors and their families.
